RELATIONS WITH DISTRICTS OUTSIDE SERVICE AREA

The main service area of the Agency is the boundary lines of CESA #9. Occasionally there may be a request for a CESA #9 program or service from a school district that is outside of the CESA #9 boundary. Such requests will be approached from the perspective of promoting inter-CESA cooperation and collaboration. The final decision on providing services outside the CESA #9 boundary will rest with the Board of Control.

It is appropriate for two or more CESAs to work together to provide a service for partnering CESAs. These joint CESA programs will be approved by the Boards of Control of all partnering CESAs and offered to school districts in all partnering CESAs.

It may be appropriate for a CESA to offer a service on a statewide basis. In such instances, prior discussions should be held with the Wisconsin Association of CESA Administrators CESA Statewide Network.
