

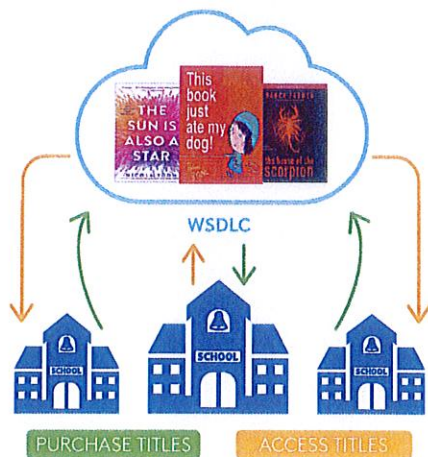
Wisconsin Schools Digital Library Consortium

What is the Wisconsin Schools Digital Library Consortium (WSDLC)?

Offered in partnership by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, CESA Purchasing, the CESA State-wide Network and WILS, the WSDLC enables any district or school in Wisconsin to access eBooks via a shared collection. All purchased titles are available to all participating districts or schools through a custom website, the OverDrive app or their own library catalog.

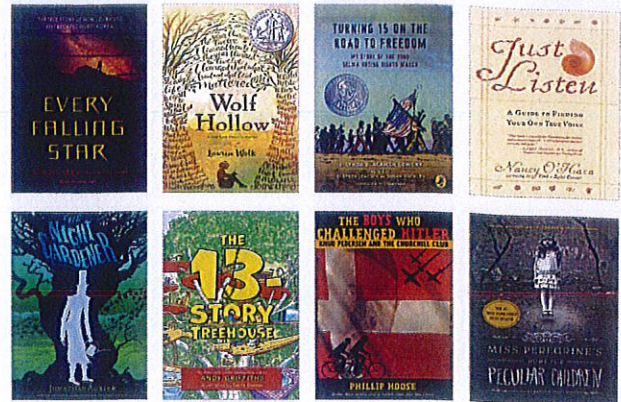
Why join?

If School A were to initiate an eBook collection of their own, they may only be able to afford 50 titles. However, by leveraging the power of sharing and joining the WSDLC, School A gains access to exponentially more of these valuable digital resources. The WSDLC will continue to grow year after year and as more districts and schools join.



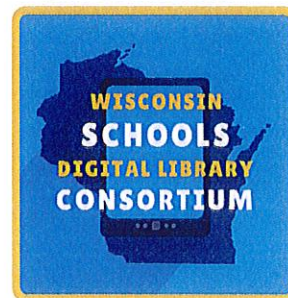
How do I get started?

- Students can access titles on smartphones, tablets, laptops, Chromebooks and desktops - either personal or school issued. Titles can also be downloaded for offline reading
